

# Sermon Discussion Questions


A God Who Defines the Terms of the Relationship *Genesis 12, 15,*17

- 1. Check out the covenant graphic. How does the concept of covenant impact our understanding of the story of Scripture? Paul writes in Galatians 3:8 that the gospel was 'announced in advance to Abraham'. How is the Abrahamic covenant an 'advanced announcement' of the New Testament gospel?
- 2. Looking at Genesis 12, what ways can we see Abram's faith as well as his struggles with faith playing out in this chapter? In Genesis 15, Abram asks God, "How can I know?" (verse 8). How does God respond to Abram's need for assurance? What does this teach us about God's character and patience?
- 3. Read through Genesis 15:9-17. Talk about the implications of God taking on the covenant curses on himself that should fall on Abraham if he breaks the covenant.
- 4. In Hebrews 11:8-10, Abram's faith is celebrated as he looked forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God. How should this forward-looking faith shape our understanding of God's promises?
- 5. The journey of Abraham is a journey of faith, struggles, mistakes, and grace. How does Abraham's journey reflect the Christian experience today?
